Addendum to the Manual

Version 6.02 of FontFX has a number of new features not covered in the manual.

This addendum describes the changes.

Overleaf is a replacement for the diagram of the FontFX control window which appears on page two of the manual.

Border Effect

The border effect now obeys the outline width setting, to give a range of thicker borders. You can also now set the gap colour. If you choose the same gap colour as fill colour, FontFX will automatically modify the gap colour to avoid potentially invisible characters.

Circle

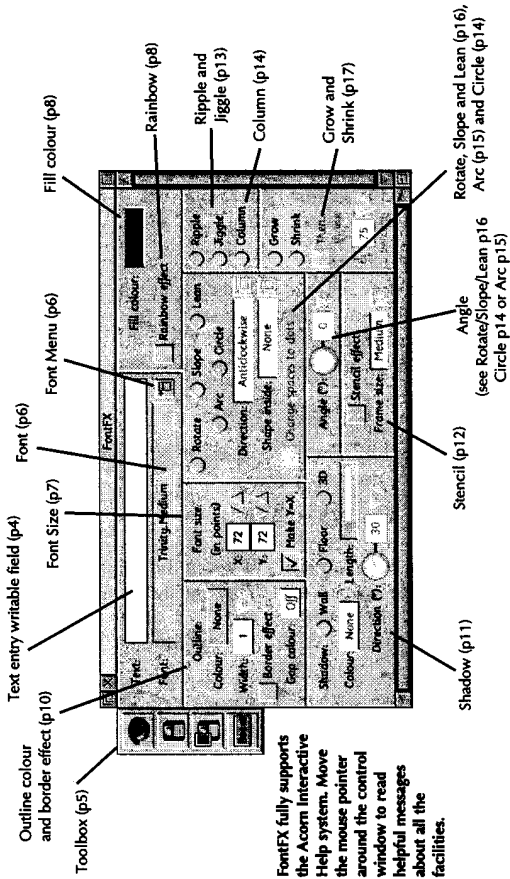
You can now use the angle compass to set the start point for text around a circle.

Grow / Shrink

It is now possible to determine how small the smallest characters are in relation to the largest when using grow or shrink. This is expressed as a percentage of full size. You can type in a value or use the arrows to alter it. The maximum is 90% and the minimum is 10%.

Script Language

To accommodate the above changes, the **BE** command now takes an optional suffix **<colour>**, which defines the gap colour. Also, **GR** and **SH** have a **<percentage>** suffix to specify the size of the smallest character. Finally, the **CI** command has been replaced by new commands **CA**, **CB** and **CC** (anticlockwise, bi-directional and clockwise circle), each of which can optionally be followed by an **<angle>** setting for the text start point.



FontFX fully supports the Acorn interactive Help system. Move the mouse pointer around the control window to read helpful messages about all the facilities.
